**Concourse:** Vehicle will be Point Judged. Awarded the Dearborn Award with a minimum of 950 points.

**Dearborn:** Must have a Dearborn Award – Point Judged - Awarded the Dearborn Medallion with a minimum of 925 points.

**Dearborn Emeritus:** Vehicle is not Point Judged. This category is open to Dearborn Award vehicles that have received at least a Dearborn Plaque plus 2 medallions. Vehicles will be visually inspected to become eligible for a Dearborn Emeritus Medallion.

**Rouge Preservation:** Vehicle will be inspected for originality of various areas.

### Concourse Division - Point Judged – Compared to Factory Condition

All eligible club vehicles entered which are to be point judged and have not previously won the Dearborn Award by the current owner. Most vehicles in this division are restored, but original vehicles may be entered if not entered in the Rouge Division. All vehicles with 950 points or more (out of 1,000) will receive the Dearborn Award. Vehicles which receive the Dearborn Award will graduate to the Dearborn Division.

### Dearborn Division - Point Judged – Compared to Factory Condition

All eligible club vehicles entered which are to be point-judged and have previously won the Dearborn Award by the current owner. Vehicles awarded 925 points or more will receive a Dearborn Medallion and Dearborn License Tab. Vehicles which have won the Dearborn License tab may be subject to a “walk around” at a subsequent meet in lieu of being point judged.

### Dearborn Emeritus Division

All eligible club vehicles entered which are not to be point-judged and have previously won a V-8 Dearborn Medallion Award, and have had a minimum of one walk-around (in other words, three Dearborn awards) by the current owner. The vehicle owner may select this class or the National Chief Judge (or his/her designee) may assign a vehicle to this class. Vehicles in this division are eligible for the Dearborn Emeritus medallion.

### Rouge Division - Judged for Originality

All eligible club vehicles unrestored, original as manufactured which meet the requirements set forth in the judging rules for the Rouge Division and are not participating in the Dearborn, Concourse, or Touring Divisions. Vehicles will be considered for certification in one or more of three areas: Interior, Exterior, and Running Gear (which includes the engine). Originality, as manufactured, is the primary criteria for certification. A minimum of 90% of the area being considered must be original from the manufacture of the vehicle to be certified for the Rouge Award or subsequent Rouge Medallion Award.

### Touring Division and Touring Division-A (Accessories) – Voted on by meet participants

All eligible club vehicles entered which are not point-judged or participating in the Rouge Division. Vehicles are eligible for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place trophies based on voting by all registered meet participants. Touring vehicles are basically stock while Touring A vehicles are allowed additional modifications. At the operational check, all Touring and Touring A Division vehicles will be checked under the hood for allowed equipment.
